



The Arc Allegany-Steuben Awarded \$28,500 Grant from NYSARC Trust Services

The Arc Allegany-Steuben has been awarded \$28,500 in grants from the Trustee Management Board of NYSARC Trust Services to support The Arc Allegany-Steuben's guardianship.

NYSARC Trust Services administers supplemental needs trusts (SNT) and pooled trusts that can make dramatic improvements to the lives of people with disabilities by enabling people to maintain financial eligibility for Medicaid and other means-tested government benefit programs. For 2025, NYSARC Trust Services is proud to fulfill its commitment to enhancing the lives of people with disabilities by awarding a total of \$1,687,293 to The Arc New York Chapters statewide.

This year, The Arc Allegany-Steuben received \$28,500 to provide guardianship services for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities who would not otherwise have a legal guardian or advocate. Supported by Chapter staff and community volunteers, The Arc Allegany-Steuben's Guardianship Program currently provides guardianship supports and services to six people.

- It's The Arc (not an acronym)
- It's not ARC or The ARC

By using our name correctly, you're helping us emphasize respect, consistency, and our identity as a nationwide network with nearly 600 chapters advocating for people with I/DD.

Tell Governor Hochul to Support People with Disabilities in FY27 Budget

The Arc New York has launched a One-Click Campaign to inform the Governor of our budget requests, and we encourage you to add your voice. By participating, you will quickly send a letter to Governor Hochul, reminding her that support for New Yorkers with I/DD must be a priority in this year's Executive Budget.

We are asking for:

- A 2.7% Targeted Inflationary Increase (TII) to ensure funding accounts for the increased cost of living and providing services
- The Careforce Affordability Initiative to support affordable housing, childcare and healthcare for direct care staff
- Infrastructure Investments to ensure funding accounts for the increased cost of living and providing services to maintain facilities, meet state climate goals, and support innovative services




NYSEG/RG&E Donates \$3,500 to The Arc Allegany-Steuben


